
Methodology

Margin of error	1.4 percentage points
Language of interview	Spanish




Were you employed full-time in Latin America the year before coming to the United States?




Were you employed full-time in Latin America the year before coming to the United States?

By Gender




More or less, how much money did you earn monthly in dollars in your last job in Latin America?










Do you think it is easier or more difficult now than a year ago to get a good-paying job in the U.S.?

Migration Patterns











Do you consider discrimination against immigrants a major problem, a minor problem, or not a problem for you and your family?




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




The anti-immigrant sentiment in the United States is making it more difficult to send money to my family.



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










By State of Residence






When you first came to the United States, did you come alone or with your family?

By Country of Birth




How frequently do you send money to your family?

Approximately how much money do you send each time you send money to your family?






By Annual Household Income



How do you usually send money to your family?



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




Remittances to Latin America from the United States

Latin American adult population (in thousands)




Percent that sends remittances regularly




Remittances to Latin America from the United States






