




1. Africa: Largest share of people on fragile lands




2. Per Capita Carbon Dioxide Emmisisons in 1998




3. Percentage of Countries with Exploitable Water Resources




4. Average Urban Growth Rates (1975-2000)




5. Number of deaths due to civil conflicts from 1944-1996 (per 100,000 people)
